Dredging and Land Reclamation

Project

The project involved dredging to remove bed sediments from Barton Broad, a large inland waterway, situated on the east coast of England. The objective of the work was to improve the soil and water quality of the Broad while improving the available navigational depth. The quantity of material dredged was approximately 300,000 cubic metres. The dredged material was pumped into a series of containment bunds to dry and consolidate.

ADBP managed the entire project planning and procurement and the initial supervision of the works. Initially a feasibility study on the contract method employed, whether direct labour or external contractor was undertaken. Upon review by the client we then managed both surveying and dredging tendering process's before making suitable awards of contract.
