Port of Sunderland Maintenance Dredging 2009

Project

The Port of Sunderland continued their long-running association with ADBP and appointed us to undertake the FEPA licensing process, and contractor selection and tendering through the EU Public Procurement route.

However, the dredging need became urgent before the necessary EU processes could be completed and ADBP were instructed to source and procure a trailing suction hopper dredger (TSHD) to undertake emergency maintenance dredging of the Corporation Quay, the turning circle and River Wear of silt and the approaches of sand.

Under the emergency works, ADBP also sourced and procured a local workboat and plough to work alongside the trailer. Both the TSHD and workboat contractors were appointed on time charter contracts and were managed by ADBP. Hydrographic pre and post dredge surveying was supplied by a third party surveyor, assisted by ADBP, for daily surveys and volume estimates for the purpose of FEPA Licence returns.
