### Project

ADBP was contracted by Shell E&P Ireland to provide a Client Representative for the Corrib Field Landfall Works. The work, undertaken in Broadhaven Bay, Co. Mayo, an undeveloped and environmentally sensitive area of North West Ireland, comprised dredging a nearshore trench, laying the pulling wire and pulling ashore the pipeline from the lay vessel, pressure testing the pipeline and backfilling the dredged trench with the as dredged material.

To ensure the pulling operation could be undertaken in early summer, preparatory work commenced in December 2008, with the issue of formal enquiries, interviewing selected tenderers and appointing a Contractor. A single team approach was developed, during an intense scheduling and costing period to ensure that the required vessels and plant were secured in order to meet the programme. Project specific procedures with their associated risk assessments were also developed to ensure HSE complied with Shell E&P Ireland's "Goal Zero" requirements.

On site the works were supervised to provide assurance that the required specifications and programmes were being met, and that there was no compromising of HSE standards.
