The Works involve the reclamation of a Platform for the construction of the New Doha International Airport. The Platform measures approximately 6,000m by 4,000m with approximately half the area projecting beyond the natural coastline. The reclamation required the dredging, placing and compacting of 60 million cubic metres of sand and the construction of armoured revetments consisting of more than 1 million tonnes of rock. The Contractor incurred considerable additional costs in performing the grossly changed works but the Engineer largely dismissed the Contractor's claims submitted on the basis that the costs incurred were the responsibility of the Contractor.

ADBP were employed to review the facts of the case and provide expert testimony during the mediation process, which contributed to a successful outcome for the client.
