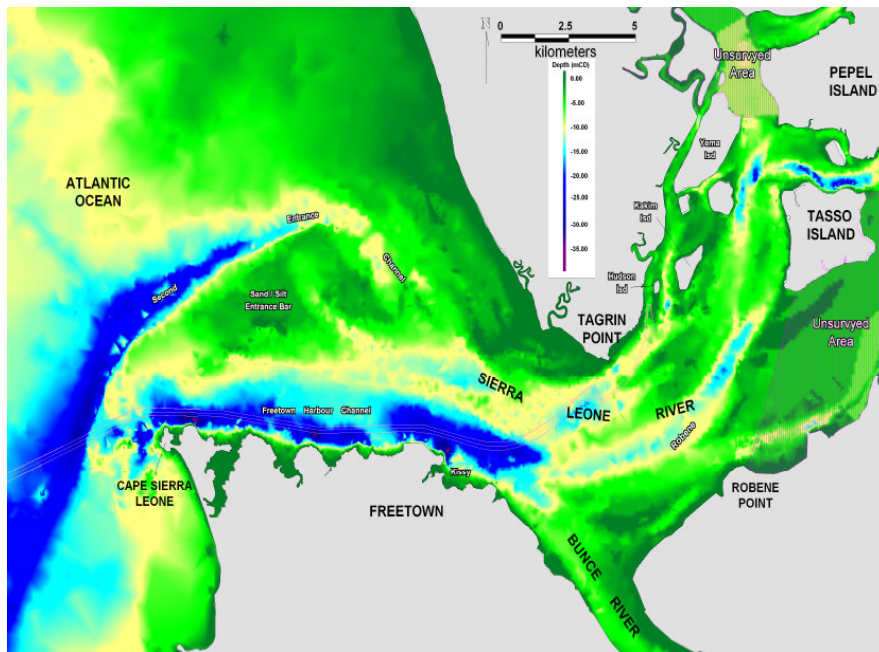

Project

The Tonkolili Iron Ore Project is located along the Sierra Leone river, near the city of Freetown, the capital of Sierra Leone. Contractor Works consisted of initial bulk dredging of the Peipel Channel and disposal of material at the designated offshore spoil ground (approximately 2.3 to 3.0 million m³).

Survey procedures ensure that the survey methods used comply with the contract specifications and that surveys are carried out in an accurate and efficient manner. The survey activities undertaken included setting out of all works, installation and acceptance of survey vessel, performing bathymetric surveys (Pre-dredge, interim, post-dredge, pre-dump, post-dump), positioning of the plant and equipment used in dredging and disposal activities, charting and volume calculations.

ADBP's client representative supervised all aspects of the surveying to ensure that quality control and procedures adopted were acceptable. This provided the client a fair and objective representation onsite and ensured the delivery of reliable data. This is critical in establishing confidence in contract measurement methods for navigation and payment purposes.
